



# Ottawa Valley River Loop

*Come and snowmobile Eastern Ontario and the Ottawa Valley*

The Ottawa Valley River Loop offers snowmobilers the opportunity to capture a favorite piece of our diverse region and lifestyle along the Ottawa River with an option to dip into Quebec. The loop is approximately 500 km (311 miles) of pure sledding as you ride into an atmosphere of warmth and camaraderie associated with our snowmobile friendly communities. If you have a FCMQ trail pass, you can take the option to dip into Quebec make the loop 425 kms (264 miles).

This one, two, or three day loop will take you through rolling hills of woodlots, open fields, pipeline corridors and abandoned rail lines. It will give you the chance to see many of Ontario's wildlife in the winter months as you sled on the well-groomed, signed trails provided by the volunteers of the many clubs that make up Snow Country Snowmobile Region and the Upper Canada Snowmobile Region.

Your starting point for Snowmobiler friendly accommodations is the Brookstreet Hotel, which can be found in heart of Ottawa in the suburb of Kanata, at the most southern tip of the WCSTA W1 trail. The Brookstreet offers shuttles to local shopping, Senators games and Canadian Tire Centre events. Hotel amenities include on-site restaurants and café, fitness studio, indoor saltwater pool, WiFi, children's wading pool &

hot tubs, and games room and kids activities. Why not stay at the Brookstreet and take in a hockey game?

Your next stop will be the Days Inn, Renfrew. The Hotel is just steps from the trail with lots of parking. The hotel's amenities include a fitness center and business centre and on-site restaurant. The hotel is located right on the WWSG 107. The hotel is close to food and fuel.

Your next stop will be the Best Western Pembroke Inn. The Hotel is just steps from the trail with lots of parking. The hotel's recreational amenities include an indoor pool, hot tub and a fitness center. The hotel is located right on the Top B Trail.

Your next stop is Calabogie at the Calabogie Peaks Resort located just off CDSC 105 and E105A. The resort is located in the heart of the Ottawa Valley, at the foot of Dickson Mountain. Maybe mix some skiing in to your trip? The resort's amenities include a fully equipped fitness center, indoor saltwater pool, an outdoor hot tub, WiFi, continental breakfast, and on-site restaurant. The community of Calabogie offers restaurants, service stations, automotive garages and a pharmacy, all located right on or off the TOP E105A.

- Calabogie to White Lake: 44 kms**
- White Lake to Ottawa (Kanata): 109 kms**
- Total: 506 kms**
