



Rideau St. Lawrence Run

Come and ride Eastern Ontario and the Ottawa Valley

The Rideau St. Lawrence Run is one of four tour loops in the Upper Canada Snowmobile Region. The loop is approximately 275 km (171 miles) of awesome sledding.

The Rideau St Lawrence Run can be ridden in one day and will take you through rolling hills of woodlots, open fields, pipeline corridors and abandoned rail lines. It will give you the chance to see many of Ontario's wildlife in the winter months as you sled on the well-groomed, signed trails provided by the volunteers of the many clubs that make up the Upper Canada Snowmobile Region.

Accommodations can be found in Smiths Falls at the Best Western located just off the Top E.

The community of Smiths Falls offers restaurants, service stations, automotive garages, a pharmacy. The Cataraqui Trail is home to a large portion of the Top E trail with great views along this old rail line.

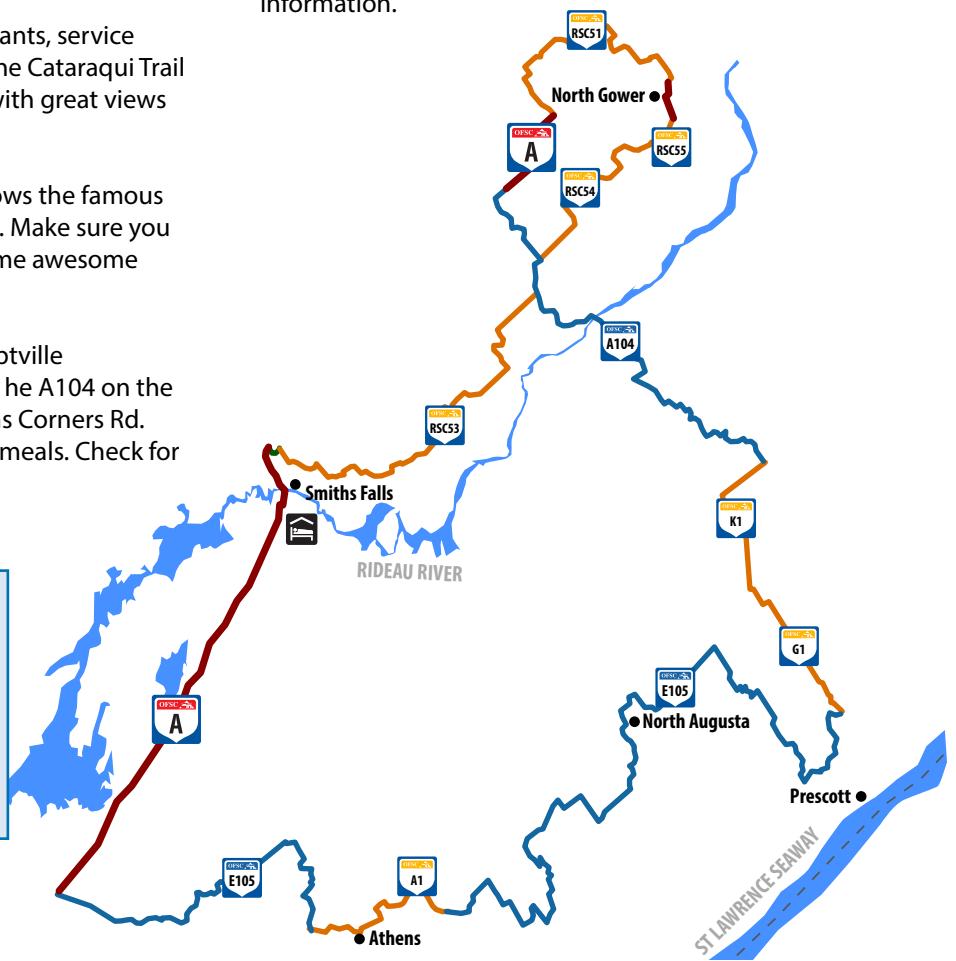
Heading north, the trail to North Gower follows the famous Rideau River. North Gower has food and fuel. Make sure you stop into the Marlborough restaurant for some awesome wings.

On the loop, make sure you stop at the Kemptville Snowmobile Klub clubhouse located just off the A104 on the K38 at the corner of O'Neill Rd and Pattersons Corners Rd. The clubhouse offer snacks, drinks and light meals. Check for hours before going.

Just north of Maynard, you will find the Grenville Snowmobile Association clubhouse, located just off the E105 on the Charleville Rd. The clubhouse offer snacks, drinks and light meals. Normally, the clubhouse is open for breakfast from 8 am to 12 pm on Saturdays and Sundays. Club house is not open during the weekdays. Check hours before going.

In the south, stop in at the Athens and District Snowmobile Club clubhouse located in Athens on 10th Line Rd just off the A1 in where it meets E105. The clubhouse offers snacks, drinks and light meals. The club is famous for 'Jim's Wings'. Check for hours before going.
