

Upper Canada Circuit

Come and ride Eastern Ontario and the Ottawa Valley

The Upper Canada Circuit is one of four tour loops in the Upper Canada Snowmobile Region. The loop is approximately 275 km (171 miles) of pure sledding.

The Upper Canada Circuit can be ridden in one or two days and will take you into an atmosphere of warmth and camaraderie associated with our snowmobile friendly communities. This loop will take you through woodlots, open fields, pipeline corridors and abandoned rail lines.

Accommodations can be found in Morrisburg at the McIntosh Country Inn located on the E105 and nearby at the Iroquois Motel located on the RS4. Accommodation around the loop may also be found at the Restauparc Motel off the SV42 in Casselman.

The community of Morrisburg also offers restaurants, service stations, automotive garages, a local snowmobile sales and service shop.

Heading west, a great stop is Osgoode, following the famous Rideau River, along the KOC and A214 trails. Great food awaits at the famous Red Dot Café where you can sled right up to the door and fuel is nearby. In the nearby town of Metcalfe, you can get service for Artic Cat sleds.

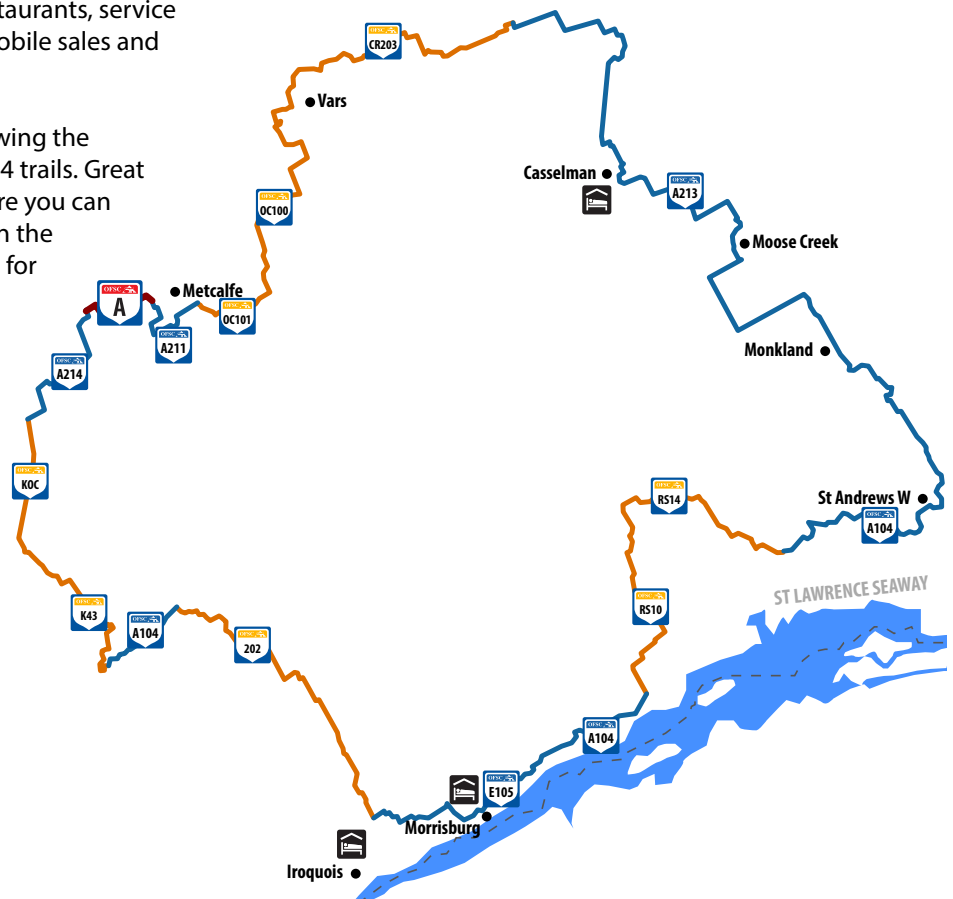
As you head east your travel will take you over Hwy 417 and through the beautiful and well-know Larose Forest on wide, safe, groomed trails.

Casselman offers a great stop along Hwy 417 and heading south on A213. Casselman offers fuel and many options for meals including Pizza Hut, Burger King and KFC.

On your way south to Monkland along the A213, don't forget to stop at the famous covered bridge for photos. The bridge is located just north of Monkland. In Monkland, you can access food and fuel.

On your way home you will cross over Hwy 401 for an amazing view. Before returning home, stop into the Riverside Snowmobile Club clubhouse located just off he A104 in Riverside Heights Park. Check for hours before going.

- Clubhouse to Morrisburg:** 7 kms
